Some of you may know that for the past three years, The Hub@BA15 has provided over 1000 food parcels to those in need. We know that this has been a welcome help to many families during school holidays when free school lunches are not available.

We want to let everyone know that we always welcome those in need. Your details can be provided to the school; alternatively you can contact the Hub directly. We also want you to know that we are able to provide parcels during non- school holidays for the entire family, not just your child or children. Your child's school is in possession of vouchers which they can sign and you can fill out. Bringing this voucher to the Hub on Church Street in Bradford on Avon allows you to receive a food parcel tailored to your family.

The Hub is open Monday to Friday from 10 to 1. Our phone number is 01225 920148 should you need any information. We are also able to help with debt advice and some welfare benefit enquiries. We have a phone and computers with printing facilities which are available for use.
