



Sixth Form Dress Code

Sixth Form students are expected to dress appropriately for the task of learning and membership of St Laurence School. A smart appearance is therefore expected of all students in the St Laurence community.

Staff are entitled to engage with students over their appearance and exercise judgement over what is suitable within the framework of this dress code. The demands of particular religious beliefs are taken into account and the dress code for Sixth Form students is as follows:

- Footwear in good condition and suitable for the context of St Laurence School. No flip flops or high heels.
- Conventional jewellery/earrings with a maximum of one nose stud and no other facial or visible body piercing.
- Clothes of suitable style with no extremes of fashion.
- Appropriate taste/decency with no crop tops, 'strappy tops', camouflage trousers or ripped jeans.
- Dresses skirts must be to a mid-thigh length.
- No beach-wear, tracksuit bottoms or leggings.
- Jeans and shorts can be worn but have to be smart.
- Reasonable hairstyle with no extremes of fashion or headwear.

Students are expected to follow this code and to participate in an annual review as fashion evolves.
