St Laurence School are delighted to be able to celebrate once again an outstanding set of A level results, particularly in the first year since the pandemic began, with all of the disruption and challenge that the students have faced.

100% of our students achieved A level passes with **87%** achieving entirely **A*- C grades**.

This led to an **average A level grade score of a B** which is outstanding for such a large year group.

Headteacher Tim Farrer said 'This cohort of students are remarkable. They did not sit their GCSEs due to lockdown and yet took on one of the most important moments of their life with maturity, dedication and courage. The school are immensely proud of them and their achievements and wish every one of them the very best of luck with their next steps.'

We are very proud that **55 students (41% of the year group)** have achieved grades of **A or A*** across their subjects. Once again, we have students who have successfully claimed Oxbridge places. 'We are a truly comprehensive school and equally as proud of all of our students. We think it is vital to celebrate all students' achievements whether they have decided to go to university, take on an apprenticeship or step into the world of work.
