

GCSE results 2022

St Laurence School are delighted to be able to celebrate once again a superb set of GCSE results, particularly in the first year since the pandemic began, with all of the disruption and challenge that the students have faced.

72% of our students achieved at least a Grade 4 in both English and Maths. Headteacher, Tim Farrer, said 'It is testament to this year group's courage and resilience that they have achieved such an excellent set of results as well as the support that has been provided by the school and guidance of their parents and carers.' We are very proud that 29 students (13% of the year group) have achieved seven or more Grade 7s or higher. 'We are a truly comprehensive school and equally as proud of all of our students. I think it is vital to celebrate all students' achievements and although some will not be joining us for sixth form, their hard work and commitment has ensured they are taking their next chosen steps with the highest grades possible' Mr Farrer added.

We have high expectations of all our students and are extremely pleased with their performance across the range of subjects. As well as English and Maths, there have been particularly strong results in Sciences, German, French, Art, and Graphics.
